- #3 Liked everything. Working in groups was helpful.
- #4 Jim used many application problems to help us learn. It was difficult but effective.
- #5 The numerous examples Dr. Brown covered really helped me to better understand the material. However, many times when we had to work in groups, most people in the class had not grasped the material well enough yet to successfully complete the example problems.
- #7 Availability of Dr. Brown was the most helpful thing.
- #8 The way he taught everything: explain, example, and then group work, I found very effective. He also mixed in the computer and the calculator since we will be using those when we enter the workforce.
- #9 I really feel like the group work was key to my in-class learning. More group work may be helpful
